WHEREAS, Richard C. Elm a tribal member/and his wife Linda K. Elm, / a non-member

of 710 Hubbard, Street, Green Bay  
have (has) made application to this Committee for a long-term lease for residential purposes, and

WHEREAS, the tribal land selected is described as follows:

Lot 10, Block 3, Cora House Subdivision, A part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 36, T. 24N., R. 19E., 4th P.M., Town of Hobart Brown County, Wis., containing 1.0 acre, more or less, subject to all valid rights-of-way of record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Committee in special session assembled, hereby requests the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency to draft a lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 (69 Stat. 539) as amended: 25 USC 415, for the above-described land with a 25-year term which shall automatically and without notice, renew for an additional term of 25 years at a total rental of 1/2 Fair Market Rental \$138.00/per year, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are authorized to execute the lease in behalf of the Oneida Tribe.
