RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: Theodore E. Christjohn, a member of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, residing at Route #1, Oneida, Wisconsin 54155, has made application for an agricultural lease of tribal land described as follows:

A parcel of land in Government Lot C within the NW1/4 Sec. 27, T. 24N., R. 19E., 4th P.M., Brown County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows: commencing at the W1/4 corner of Sec. 11, thence South on the Section line 825.0 ft.; thence East 264.0 ft. to the point of beginning; thence South 330.0 ft.; thence East 1056.0 ft.; thence North 330.0 ft.; thence West 1056.0 ft., to the point of beginning, containing 8.0 acres, more or less, subject to all valid rights-of-way of record, and


WHEREAS: The lessee has offered to pay a consideration of \$80.00 per year for a period of five years, beginning as of the date of approval of the lease,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency is hereby authorized to prepare and approve the lease in accordance with Departmental Regulations 25 CFR, 131; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to sign the lease for and in behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
