WHEREAS the Oneida Tribe has utilized more effective services to their own members, and

WHEREAS the Oneida Tribe will continually provide information and develop new and effective changes for the provision and utilization of Health services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby, once again request direct funding for the Community Health Representative Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oneida Health Representatives are working as a team with the Health Center Staff team making periodical reviewing cases:

- A. Such as reports, oral and written with number of patients seen, number of positive findings and number referred to other agencies for medical or dental care.
- B. Information, referrals and direction for patient care management.
- C. Evaluation from professional personal on programs and care.
- D. Sources of information from other Outreach Team members, County Nurses, Visiting Nurses, Dentists, Physicians, Alcohol and Mental Health Counselors.
