WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. have attempted to restore its ancestral lands whenever possible, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Lutheran Church site presently is on the Real Estate market, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee has determined that there is a possible use for the three buildings and land in question, and

WHEREAS, the suggested use of this land may include the site of an alcoholism rehabilitation center, a possible training site for Tribal members and or some other type of program that would be beneficial to the Oneida Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. is making a formal bid on land in question for a purchase price in the amount of (\$20,000.00) twenty thousand dollars.
