RESOLUTION # 17-21-89A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and


WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has determined the need for modern agriculture equipment to enhance and implement it's agricultural operations, and

WHEREAS, contractual agreements to purchase such equipment are being processed with Reisterer Equipment, Inc. of Pulaski, WI which recite lease terms as well as an option to purchase said equipment which is listed,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the contracts referred to above are hereby incorporated into this resolution and that the option to purchase will not be exercised until after the 36th month and not before the beginning of the 37th month from the date said agreements are executed
