

Resolution No. 7-22-76-B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee is the duly constituted governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin of the Oneida Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Development Corporation is a tribally chartered organization formed for the primary purpose to act as General Contractors for the Oneida Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Development Corporation on tribal projects will utilize "Force Account" methods where practical and / or approved, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Development Corporation has been awarded the general, electric and electric heating contracts as a "Force Account" contracts approved by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Development Corporation is in the process of constructing a nursing home facility for the elderly, and

WHEREAS, the construction of the nursing home will provide employment and training for the unskilled laborer of the Oneida Community, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Development Corporation will continue to employ the unskilled laborer and pay the prevailing wage for unskilled labor

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee request the Hill - Burton Program to waive the Davis - Bacon Wage Act for the "Force Account" of the Oneida Tribal Development Corporation in the construction of this nursing home project.
