RESOLUTION NO. 8-17-79-B

WHEREAS: The draft perspective for 1981, HEW, ANA states that the initiative will be the development of Tribal Social and Economic Development Offices. (Tesdos), and

WHEREAS: On page three of the perspective, it states "The Indian Tribes with proven energy resources will receive priority in establishing tesdos" and

WEHREAS: Such a policy would be detromental to the development of Social and Economic self-sufficiency of Tribes that do not presently have proven energy resources and

WHEREAS: no justification or rational basis for this apparently discriminitory policy has been advanced.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council, Inc. Board of Directors is presently opposed to any funding allocation criteria that draws a distinction between Tribes that have proven energy resources and Tribes that do not.
