NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby approves the up-dated O.E.D.P.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of the Oneida O.E.D.P. be distributed to all of the various Government Agencies with whom the Oneida Tribe has contact.
