## Request for BIA to Begin Trust Acquisition Process

- WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV, as amended, and
- WHEREAS, Article IV (f) of the Oneida Constitution authorizes the appropriation of available Tribal funds for public purposes, and
- WHEREAS, funds are presently available for the purchase of the following parcel of land:
- Beginning at point where N/L CL intersects Ridge Road thence N AL N/L CL 561 ft SW 412.5 feet SE 535.26 ft to CTR. of HY NE AL HY 462 ft to BEG, part of Claim 68 Twn 23, Rng 19E. 5.5 Acres, and.
- WHEREAS, the above property is now held in fee simple status,
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process necessary to acquire the above parcel in Trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians.
