

## RESOLUTION NO. 8-29-77-A

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. is empowered by the Oneida Tribal Constitution to create subordinate organizations for the good of the Oneida people, and
  - WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the responsibility to carry on the Tribal business, and
  - WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has recognized Economic Development as a high-priority to improve the economic conditions of the reservation, and
  - WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has completed an acceptable feasibility report for the development of the Oneida Forms Corporation, and
  - WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe intends to form a Tribal Corporation (for profit) to operate a printed forms plant, and
  - WHEREAS, such corporation will be subject to all applicable Tribal ordinances, laws, rules, regulations or codes governing its operation now in effect or hereafter enacted, and
  - WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe desires to engage Litton Graphics Division of Litton Industries, Inc. to manage the plant and to render related training, engineering, marketing services, and
  - WHEREAS, Litton Graphics Division is willing to provide such services on terms to be negotiated in the management agreement.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. hereby intends to implement the creation of a Tribal Corporation to engage in the manufacturing of printed forms and agrees to negotiate terms of a management agreement with Litton Graphics Division.

### CERTIFICATION
