

Please remember that any violation which occurs after this date may again effect your eligibility to remain employed within the Oneida Tribe. If you happen to violate any law which would make you ineligible for employment or continued employment, then you will no longer be permitted to work within the Oneida Tribe's operation (per Tribal policy and procedures).
