ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN

REQUEST GRANT FOR 1976

RESOLUTION - F.Y. 1976

WHEREAS, it is the highest priority of the Oneida Business Committee to eliminate substandard housing and to realize as soon as possible the goal of a decent, safe, and sanitary living environment for all members of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, funds are to be made available to the Tribe, 1976 Home Improvement Program on the Oneida Reservation by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee requests the responsibility of management, performance of work, furnishing materials, supplies, equipment, employing necessary personnel to carry out the Home Improvement Program in f.y. 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has demonstrated its ability to successfully execute such a program in the past.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests a budget of \$ 11,700.00 to carry on the Home Improvement Program as provided by Washington criteria, and published April 25, 1975, under the following categories:

- Category A. Repairs to housing that will remain non-standard.
- Category B. Repairs to housing that will become standard.
- Category C. Down payments
- Category D. New housing.

It is understood that any homes built in accordance with specifications approved by the Superintendent personally. This resolution also authorizes application for any subsequent grants made available for Home Improvement in Category D will be in accordance with specifications approved by the Superintendent personally.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon availability of funds the budget requested will be made available, and advances be made consistent only with the progress of the Home Improvement Program by the Tribe. It is understood that funds being made available under this request are to be used for the Home Improvement Program during f.y. 1976.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee shall take all necessary action to effectively administer said request in accordance with the "Criteria and Administration" published April 25, 1975, as amended by future years publication by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to sign any necessary documents in connection with the request, and that the proposal submitted with this resolution will contain the priority list for the program.
