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R E S O L U T I O N

BEING, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc., has for some time been closely involved and attentive to the administration of Indian Relief under Chapter 49.046, Wisconsin Statutes, as it applies to their members residing in Outagamie County and,

BEING, our personal experience and statistical data indicates considerable cause for concern as to the responsiveness of this program meeting the legislative intent of the Statute,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wisconsin Department of Health and Social Services, along with such other local, state, and federal agencies as are appropriate, take immediate steps to fully investigate the technical considerations necessary to enable the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc., to administer said program on their own behalf.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Great Lakes Agency, initiate such action as to result in a preliminary meeting, to be held within 30 days, of all parties concerned with this request.
