RESOLUTION NO. 73-9-10

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal membership reflects approximately 7000 members and

WHEREAS, half of this Tribal membership resides in Outagamie and Brown Counties near the village of Oneida, and

WHEREAS, those Oneida persons who are conversant in the Oneida language are limited to less than 100 persons, and

WHEREAS, there is a genuine interest throughout the Oneida population, particularly among the youth, to learn and use the language of the Oneida people, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Council did endorse and approve the Pilot Linguistics Project--Native American Languages through UW--Milwaukee, sponsored by GLITC, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee, by recommendation of the Oneida Education Committee, does request that the Oneida segment of Pilot Linguistics Project--Native American Languages be taught on site at the Oneida Reservation so that a maximum number of Oneida persons may participate in the program

BE, IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Project Director work closely with the Oneida Education Committee to re-develop an appropriate budget.
