**WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oneida Business Committee is delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Pardon and Forgiveness Screening Committee reviewed the pardon application of Valerie Ventura at a duly called hearing held on August 18, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the requirements of the Pardon and Forgiveness Law have not been fulfilled.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Oneida Business Committee by this resolution hereby:

Denies the pardon of Valerie Ventura, for the crime(s) of Conspiracy to Import Heroin, and notifies her that she may request another pardon after one (1) year from the date of certification of this document. The pardon has been denied based on the following:
