RESOLUTION NO. 9-21-94 F

Continuing Resolution to operate at current budget

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida business Committee is proposing the implementation of a two year Budget Plan, and

WHEREAS, the concentration is on planning and strategizing for the future, and

WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council requires a definitive budget for their final approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tribal expenditures will continue at a level consistent with the basic requirements to provide service. In order to provide definitive guidelines the following considerations are made:

1. Spending level consistent with the approved FY '94 budget.
2. Allowance for growth in operations shall not exceed 5% of the approved FY '94 Budget.
3. Community and economic development operations implemented in FY '94 will remain consistent with approved Business Plans.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That the proposed FY 95/96 budget will be presented by the Treasurer to the General Tribal Council for their review and adoption at a Special General Tribal Council meeting on January 16, 1995.
