WHEREAS, Joseph Jordan has applied for a home loan in the amount of \$14,000.00 from the First National Bank of Seymour, Wisconsin and

WHEREAS, Mr. Joseph Jordan has requested the Oneida Tribe of Indians to approve and ratify an assignment of lease document to the First National Bank of Seymour.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Oneida Business Committee in regular session assembled does hereby approve and ratify the assignment of lease No. B-716 (73) to the First National Bank of Seymour, Wisconsin in the amount of \$14,000.00.
