RESOLUTION # 10-16-92-13

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a Federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the law of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated authority under Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin wishes to improve the provision of effective family services to the Oneida Community, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe wishes to exercise more flexibility in the delivery of improved family services to the Oneida Community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin hereby agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in the 1992-93 State and Tribe Contract for Human Services and Income Maintenance Program in the amount of \$459,974.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribal Chairman, or his delegate, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto.
