
R E S O L U T I O N

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has made these funds available, in the amount of 90,373.00 for Fiscal Year 1978
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee hereby makes application for the planning funds available under PL 93-638 and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Chairman of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wis. is hereby authorized to sign the necessary application forms to execute this grant.
