RESOLUTION # 10-21-83-A

WHEREAS, The Oneida Housing Authority was established under Tribal Ordinance on April 20, 1963 to provide and promote better living conditions for all persons residing on the Oneida Reservation; and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Housing Authority is providing safe and sanitary housing for Oneida people; and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Housing Authority is requesting HUD to reconsider the re-establishment of maximum rents, due to the hardships placed on the tenants.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The the Oneida Tribal Business Committee supports this request by the Oneida Housing Authority and requests that every consideration from HUD be given this matter.
