- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Committee in special session assembled hereby requests the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency to draft a lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 (69 Stat. 539) as a mended: 25 USC 415, for the above-described land with a 25 year term which shall automatically and without notice, renew for an adterm which shall automatically and without notice, renew for an additional term of 25 years at a total rental of 1/2 fair market rental \$138.00 per year, and

  Committee are authorized to execute the lease in behalf of the Oneida

  Tribe.
