RESOLUTION # 10-29-97-Q

Stanley and Loretta Webster and Rae Schrap Residential Lease

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a Federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Loretta R. Webster, # 1525 and Stanley R. Webster, #6346, as husband and wife and Rae M. Schrap, #8941, a/are Tribal Member(s), have made application for a long-term lease for residential purposes; and

WHEREAS, Loretta R. Webster, # 1525 and Stanley R. Webster, #6346, as husband and wife and Rae M. Schrap, #8941, has/have been designated Lease No. RL-2910(97) for the Tribal land selected and is more particularly described as follows: 3781 Hillcrest Drive, Green Bay, WI 54313.

Part of Lot 2, Volume 18, Certified Survey Maps, Page 97, Brown County Records, Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, Fourth Principal Meridian, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 2, Volume 18, Certified Survey Maps, Page 97, Brown County Records; thence N44°31'45" W, 271.95 feet along the west line of said Lot 2; thence N45°28'15"E, 204.14 feet; thence S76°51'08"E, 106.07 feet; thence S3°20'42"E, 302.18 feet; thence 81.87 feet along the right-of-way of Bernarrs Way, being the arc of a 65.00 foot radius curve to the left whose long chord bears S81°33'23"W, 76.57 feet to the point of beginning. Parcel contains 55,492 square feet/1.27 acres, more or less. Subject to easements of record.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin's Division of Land Management is responsible for managing all tribal real property assets, including leases, through rules and policies approved in Oneida Real Property Law; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Committee in Regular assembled, hereby requests the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, to draft a lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 (69 Stat, 539), as amended, 25 USC 415, for the above-described land with a 25 year term which shall automatically and without notice renew for an additional term of 25 years at a total rental, \$1.00 per year or \$50 for fifty years, at a total rental to be determined by an appraisal, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Christine M. Doxtator, Land Management Director, or her designee, be authorized to execute said lease agreement on behalf of the Oneida Tribe.
