Melinda Danforth Cancellation of Lease

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Melinda K. Danforth, a tribal member is holder of said lease no. RL-2558(94) more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of land in the SW ¼, SW ¼, Section 10, Township 24 North, Range 19 E., 4th P.M., Brown County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 10, thence from said initial point by metes and bounds, North on the section line, 330 feet; thence East 264 feet; thence South 330 feet, to a point on the South section line of said Section 10; thence West on the section line, 264 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.0 acres, more or less, subject to valid existing rights-of-way of record.

WHEREAS, Melinda K. Danforth holder of said leaseholder no longer wish to use said lease site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in <u>Regular</u> session assembled hereby approve the above modification of lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease **CANCELLATION** documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
