RESOLUTION 73-11-5 A

WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE IS A PARTICIPANT IN THE NATIVE AMERICAN PROGRAMS, AND

WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE WELCOME THE OPPORTUNITY TO INVOKE THE SELF DETERMINATION POLICY,

WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE FIND THEMSELVES AT A GREAT DISADVANTAGE UNDER THE PRESENT ADMINISTRATIVE SET-UP OF NATIVE AMERICAN PROGRAMS,

WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE HAVE THE CAPABILITIES AND THE FACILITIES ADMINISTER ANY AND ALL PROGRAMS IN WHICH THEY ARE INVOLVED,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE ONEIDA TRIBE PETITION MR. ROBERT HOWARD TO ASSIST THE ONEIDA TRIBE IN THE ACQUISITION OF CONDUCT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THEIR OWN PROGRAMS, AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THIS RESOLUTION BE SENT TO ALL PARTIES WOULD POSSIBLY BE OF ASSISTANCE IN ACQUIRING THESE PROGRAMS,
