Because of the help of this Oneida Chief in cementing a friendship between the six nations and the Colony of Pennsylvania, a new nation, the United States was made possible.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe is currently involved with the development of a land use study for reservation lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Business Committee authorizes the Bureau of Indian Affairs to formulate a contract to obtain \$3,725 for aerial maps that will be used in a land-use study.
