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RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is conducting a Home Improvement Program and is duly funded for such program on behalf of the Oneida Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the funds so allocated will be used for the purpose of home improvement through renovation of such designated homes by the Local Housing Authority located on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to negotiate a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate the project, and

WHEREAS, the Business Committee is agreeable to securing the labor and materials to carry out the program:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby authorizes the Chairman and the Secretary to enter into and execute a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs whereby the Tribe is to provide the labor and materials for the Home Improvement Program with funds allocated by the Bureau in accordance with terms and conditions contained in said contract.
