## RESOLUTION 11-17-75-3

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has approved a Revised and Amended Constitution, By-Laws and Charter at a meeting of the General Tribal Council on January 4, 1975,
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee was instructed to make minor changes as might be required by our Trustee (BIA),
- WHEREAS, the necessary meetings with the Agency and Area have been accomplished,
- WHEREAS, on September 25, 1975, the Field Solicitor, approved a draft of the Revised and Amended Constitution, By-Laws and Charter,
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee does hereby concur and approve the Field Solicitors draft of the Revised and Amended Constitution, By-Laws and Charter,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Interior be, and hereby is requested to call Secretarial election to ratify, or reject the Revised and Amended Constitution, By-Laws and Charter.

### CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Oneida Tribal Business Committee, hereby certify that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee is composed of 9 members of whom 5 constitute a quorum. 8 members were present at a meeting duly called, noticed, and held on the 17 day of NOV 1975; that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by a vote of 7 members for, 0 members against, 0 members not voting, and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
