Determination To Acquire

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV, as amended, and

WHEREAS, Article IV (f) of the Oneida Constitution authorizes the appropriation of available tribal funds for public purposes, and

WHEREAS, funds are presently available for the purchase of the following parcels of land:

WHEREAS, the owners of record of said properties on file in the offices of the Register of Deeds in the respective counties of Brown and Outagamie are:

WHEREAS, the Oneida Housing Authority, Oneida Land Committee Representative, Bureau of Indian Affairs Housing Specialist, Indian Public Health Service, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and Oneida Tribal Planning Office have determined that the above mentioned parcels are acceptable for the use of public assisted housing, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee has determined that the acquisition of the above parcel is in the best interest of the Oneida Tribe, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Planning Office be authorized to initiate and effectuate the real property acquisition process, based upon the established guidelines and procedures, and utilizing the funds allocated for this purpose.
