RESOLUTION NO. 72-12-4

WHEREAS, the monies for utilities for the Oneida Head Start Center have been delayed several months for no apparent reason,

WHEREAS, this inefficiency causes undue hardship for the sponsor,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians act, and do hereby request Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council to facilitate these payments on a regular basis.
