Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Oneida Tribal Business Committee hereby makes application for this grant, and

Be It Further Resolved that the Chairman of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wis. is hereby authorized to sign the necessary application forms to execute this grant.
