## RESOLUTION 12-8-78-F

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee elected by the General Tribal Council to oversee the jurisdiction and business of the Tribe, as authorized by the Council, with powers stated in Article IV of the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin Constitution and By-Laws.

WHEREAS, this authority has been delegated to the Oneida Business Committee as agents of the General Tribal Council.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee recognizes the need for open space and outdoor recreation opportunities.


WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee accepts the recommendations of the Oneida Land Committee with amendments and the Oneida Recreation Committee; on the Oneida Reservation Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee, acting within its power, approves the final adoption of the Oneida Reservation Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribal Planning Office be and they are hereby authorized to release the adopted Oneida Reservation Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan and pursue development and funding sources.
