RESOLUTION # 12-18-91-F

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Vickie and Joseph Webster, both tribal members are holders of lease no. B-701(72), described as follows:

A parcel of land within the NW1/4NW1/4, Section 29, T 23 n., R 19 E., 4th P.M., Wisconsin, more particularly described as: Commencing at the NW corner of said Section 29, thence East on the Section line 1209 ft. to the junction of County Trunks "E" and "EE" thence S30° W., 356 ft. to the point of beginning; thence from said point of beginning by metes and bounds N 77° W., 240 ft.; thence S 26° W., 121 ft.; thence South and East 225 ft; more or less, to a point on the centerline of County Trunk "E" which is 496 ft. from the interesection of the centerline of County Trunks "E" and "EE", thence N 30° E 140 ft. to the point of beginning containing .70 acres, more or less.


WHEREAS, Vickie Webster and Joseph Webster (deceased), no longer wish to use said lease site.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee in Regular Session assembled, hereby approves the *CANCELLATION of lease no. B-701(72),

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease *CANCELLATION documents for and in behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
