RESOLUTION NO. 12-27-76

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of the Oneida Reservation was organized in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (40 stat. 984).

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Council members met in special session on December 27, 1976 to consider this matter.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe desires to preserve and promote the conservation of its natural resources, including wildlife and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee requests of the Bureau of Indian Affairs \$25,000. as a planning grant, or such other assistance available through the Bureau for the purpose of establishing a Natural Resource and Wildlife Conservation Program on the Oneida Indian Reservation of Wisconsin.
