WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Steven R. Danforth and Connie L. Danforth, both tribal members, have made application for a long-term lease for residential purposes; and

WHEREAS, the tribal land selected is described as follows:

The South 330 Feet of Lot 7, located within SW1/4SW1/4 Section 21, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, 4th P.M., containing 2.00 acres, more or less, subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe.
