RESOLUTION 12-29-81 A

WHEREAS, The oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has leased a number of tracts of Tribal trust land to the Oneida Housing Authority on which has been constructed numerous homes for low income Oneida families, and

WHEREAS, Several of such homes have been constructed on lots in planned homesite developments which are served with communal water supply systems and garbage pick-up and disposal service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Oneida Tribe of Indians agrees, in addition to the continuation of the services enumerated above to extend those services, where applicable, to any further construction of homes for the Oneida families under sponsorship of the Oneida Housing Authority and superior agencies.
