Whereas: The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin desires to foster the

development of a stable, diversified local economy and economic activities which provide jobs, promote economic well-being and

reduce dependency on welfare services, and

Whereas: A feasibility study has been performed which indicates a positive

development potential for a hotel on Tribal lands which could provide 150 new jobs plus profit revenue for the Tribe, and

Whereas: The Administration for Native Americans has grant assistance

available to fund key staff persons for the development of

this hotel, and
