BC Resolution # 10-24-18-E Regarding Pardon of Eleanor Swett

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Pardon and Forgiveness Screening Committee reviewed the pardon application of Eleanor Swett at a duly called hearing held August 16, 2018; and
- WHEREAS,** the requirements of the Pardon and Forgiveness Law have not been fulfilled; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee by this resolution hereby;

- Denies the forgiveness of Eleanor Swett, for the crime(s) of retail theft and notifies her that she may request another forgiveness after one (1) year from the date of certification of this document. The forgiveness has been denied based on the following:
1. Outstanding debts.
 2. No call, no show at hearing.
