BC Resolution # 10-14-20-R

Designated Tribal Representative to the North American Indigenous Games

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the "North American Indigenous Games is a multi-sport event and cultural celebration involving Indigenous athletes from across North America to hold a "Games for the Indigenous Peoples" of North America with the vision was to improve the quality of life for Indigenous Peoples by supporting self-determined sports and cultural activities which encourage equal access to participation in the social/cultural/spiritual fabric of the community in which they reside and which respects Indigenous distinctiveness", see www.naigcouncil.com; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation participates in the North American Indigenous Games along with native Nations within Wisconsin to allow our children opportunities to compete and to network with other indigenous peoples;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee reconfirms its support and participation in the North American Indigenous Games.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that Cristina Danforth, Treasurer, is designated as the Tribal Representative.
