BC Resolution # 12-09-20-E FY20 Indian Housing Block Grant

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation has determined that the overall goal of the Nation is to protect, maintain, and improve the standard of living of the Oneida community; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation recognizes that housing is a key factor to the Nation's success and wellbeing; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation supports the efforts of the Comprehensive Housing to provide affordable homes for the Oneida Community; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation acknowledges Comprehensive Housing's long history of working with the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to achieve the Nation's housing goals;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida Nation will allow the Comprehensive Housing to apply, on behalf of the Oneida Nation, to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development for \$5 million dollars to fund the next step in the Nation's Comprehensive Housing Strategic Plan.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Oneida Nation will allow the Comprehensive Housing to use the \$1.8 million dollars remaining in its grant accounts as a match for the 2020 Indian Housing Block Grant Application.
