
RESOLUTION NO. 3-15-06-X

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:  
Former John Philipsen and Gertrude Philipsen Property, by her Power of Attorney,  
Rosella Peters.
- WHEREAS, the parcel is described as follows:  
Legal Description: See attached.  
Tax Parcel Number: 17-0-0682-00
- WHEREAS, the above described parcel is requested in Trust Status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide an existing residential and agricultural land use, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests that the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcels in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

A parcel of land located in the SW1/4 of the SW1/4, Section 33, Township 24 North, Range 19 East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, which is more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the SW corner of said Section 33; thence  $N00^{\circ}15'43''W$ , 125.04 feet along the West line of said SW1/4 to the point of beginning; thence continuing  $N00^{\circ}15'43''W$  1202.48 feet along said West line to the NW corner of the SW1/4 of the SW1/4 of said Section 33; thence  $S89^{\circ}51'13''E$ , 1314.68 feet along the North line of said SW1/4 of the SW1/4 to the NE corner of said SW1/4 of the SW1/4; thence  $S00^{\circ}16'40''E$ , 969.64 feet along the East line of said SW1/4 of the SW1/4; thence  $N88^{\circ}35'37''W$ , 664.85 feet ; thence  $S00^{\circ}08'24''E$ , 261.75 feet to a point on the Northerly right-of-way line of G.B. & W. Rail Road; thence  $N88^{\circ}35'37''W$ , 650.07 feet along said Northerly right-of-way line to the point of beginning. Together with privileges and subject to obligations of any and all restrictions, easements, right-of-ways of record, public highways, and holding tank agreement.
