Fair Elections 2006


- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin;
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has made contributions to political organizations representing both political parties; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin's participation in the political process has recently, in itself, become a political issue; and
- WHEREAS,** there has been criticism of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin that falsely gives the impression that past contributions were either illegal, improper or both; and
- WHEREAS,** these criticisms communicate the implicit message that Native American gaming is somehow illegal or unsavory in nature.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin will set the record straight concerning any campaign advertisement that is either false or misleading.

THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, if the Tribe responds to false or misleading campaign advertising, the information documenting the errors will be provided to all of the candidates for the office where the false or misleading information was advertised.
