Oneida Community Health Center/Dental Clinic-ADA Health Foundation/Samuel Harris Fund for Children's Dental Health Dentistry Grant Program FY 2002-2003

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe has determined its mission for the Oneida Community Health Center/Dental Clinic is to "provide a vital component of holistic health by working together as a team to guarantee quality dental care and improve the quality of life for the future of the Oneida Community", and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe through the Oneida Dental Clinic would like to provide culturally sensitive, community based dental services for Oneida community children, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe believes that the Oneida Family and Community will be strengthened by providing critically needed services that will have a positive impact on family and youth/ health and healing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin/Oneida Community Health Center/Dental Clinic Program in collaboration with the ADA Health Foundation/Samuel Harris Fund for Children's Dental Health Dentistry Grant Program, authorizes and submits this grant application for a critically needed Dental Well Child Clinic.
